



Local History Investment

In partnership with the South Milwaukee Historical Society and the South Milwaukee Industrial Museum, SMPL started a digital archive of South Milwaukee history in 2021. Our digital collections include a set of city directories dating back to 1912, a set of South Milwaukee High School Bay Mist yearbooks, 1926-2012, and a nearly complete collection of Bucyrus-Erie 'Scoop' magazines, from 1919-1983. The library also has digitized a set of scrapbooks from 1930-1992. The books contain hundreds of news items and articles from the local newspaper related to the library and events. All are accessible via the "Local History" tab at the library's website and are keyword searchable.
