

South Milwaukee Public Library Archival Finding Aid

Scope: The SMPL Archives contain materials mostly related to the history of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin and the South Milwaukee Public Library. The bulk of the original materials are related to the library's history. The materials in the City of South Milwaukee files are mostly items published by the city that were once part of the library's general reference collection or materials from the library's old local history 'vertical file.' The archive also includes the unprocessed papers of the South Milwaukee Women's Club, and smaller unprocessed boxes of items from the South Milwaukee Association of Commerce and VFW Post 3742.

Access Restrictions: There are no access restrictions on these materials, and the collection is open to all members of the public in accordance with state law. All materials must be viewed at the library, with the exception of the microfilm. As SMPL does not have a microfilm reader, arrangements will be made for anyone wishing to view microfilm reels to do so at the Cudahy Family Library.
