Computer Lab Policy

Approved by the Library Board of Trustees, 7/28/2025

The South Milwaukee Library has a Computer Lab for public usage. By using the space, patrons agree to abide by all library policies, particularly the Computer Use Policy, Meeting Room Policy, and Code of Conduct. Patrons must be 18 years or older to use the room, or a patron 18 or older must remain in the room with any users under 18 during the entire use. There is a maximum capacity of 10 people. All reservations are available on a first-come, first-served basis and may be made up to 90 days in advance. This space can be booked or used for the following purposes:

Meeting Room Space

The Computer Lab serves as a Meeting Room for public use. To serve as a meeting space, the room must be used by groups of 3 or more (max of 10). Users agree to the Meeting Room Policy and must file an application to use the room for this purpose.

Computer Access

The Computer Lab has computers, a scanner, and TV monitor available for public use. To use the room for this technology, patrons must check in at the desk. Patrons may use the room for computer access for 2 hours per day, with all use ending at least 15 minutes prior to closing.

Nintendo Switch 2

The Library has a Nintendo Switch 2 available for public usage. The Computer Lab must be reserved for this use and can be reserved for 2 hours per day, with all reservations ending at least 15 minutes prior to closing. Patrons may use Switch games checked out from the library or bring their own. Patrons must sign the Nintendo Switch 2 User Agreement Form.

Private Infant Feeding Space

The library has been recognized by the South Milwaukee/St. Francis Health Department as a Breastfeeding-Friendly Business. The Computer Lab serves as the library's Private Infant Feeding Space. The room does not require a reservation for this usage. Please let staff know at the desk and they will provide access to the room.
