Per ARTICLE IX – AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS Section 1. which state: These bylaws may be amended, in whole or in part, by two-thirds vote of those present at a meeting of the Friends provided that the meeting notice contains specific notice of intention and that a summary of proposed change/changes is included, I am proposing the following changes to the Friends Bylaws:

# **Proposed Amendments to Friends of South Milwaukee Library Bylaws**

These changes were suggested by Lynn Meidam, a local attorney and 2023 president of the Llbrary Board after some confusion interpreting our current bylaws. Both changes are similar to wording already in the Library Bylaws.

### **Current Bylaws**

ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6. The term of the president, vice president and other officers is one year; however, they may continue to serve, if reelected, for an additional two terms.

## **Proposed Change** (Add language in bold type.)

ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6. The term of the president, vice president and other officers is one year; however, they may continue to serve, if reelected, for an additional two terms. **No member shall be eligible to serve more than three consecutive terms in the same office.** 

# **Current Bylaws**

ARTICLE VII - MEETINGS

Section 1. The Friends Board may hold an annual meeting once a year, at a time and place determined by the board. <u>Fifteen members shall constitute a quorum</u>, and action on motions shall be decided by a vote of a majority of those present. Notices of meetings shall be sent two weeks in advance of the date thereof.

**Proposed Change** (Change definition of a quorum from 15 members to those present.) ARTICLE VII – MEETINGS

Section 1. The Friends Board may hold an annual meeting once a year, at a time and place determined by the board. **The members present at any properly announced meeting shall constitute a quorum**, and action on motions shall be decided by a vote of a majority of those present. Notices of meetings shall be sent two weeks in advance of the date thereof.

Finally, Lynn stated in her November 1, 2023 email: "I interpret Article IV Section 3 to set the maximum number of consecutive terms a member may serve to be 3 terms for a total of nine. After 3 terms, the member must wait one year. If a member serves one three year term, and is not elected the fourth year, that member could start another series of 3 terms in year five."
