Hoopla

To access FREE e-books, audiobooks, movies, music, and e-magazines from hoopla you will need:

- An email address
- Your library card & PIN number
- A mobile device or computer
- An Internet connection (to borrow and download items)

How to install & use hoopla

- If using hoopla via app on your mobile device:
 Download hoopla from your app store.
- Register for a hoopla account by visiting hoopladigital.com or using the hoopla app.
- Get started by selecting Browse on your computer or in the app, selecting a format that you would like to explore.
- You can also search for a specific title by clicking on the Search box or magnifying glass and typing in your title(s)/keyword.

hoopa

- To borrow a title, click on the title and then click the Borrow button.
 - Your borrowed titles can be played right after borrowing, and found under the My hoopla tab for viewing or listening.
- Borrowed titles will be automatically returned when your lending period is over.
- There are no holds, wait lists, or late fees for any hoopla instant title.
- The Milwaukee County
 System limits the number
 of checkouts to 4 titles per
 month, and unused
 checkouts do not "roll over"
 from month to month.
